

# **CAMERON ROSE**

Cameron Rose founded CANTORI – Choral Artists of East Texas in 2019, and has served as Director of Choral Activities at the University of Texas at Tyler since 2008. Previously he was Founder/Conductor of the Utah Master Chorale, Assistant Conductor of the University of Utah Singers, and Assistant Conductor/Chorus Master of the American West Symphony and Chorus. He also served in arts administration with the Los Angeles Philharmonic and Hollywood Bowl.

Dr. Rose's compositions have been performed by numerous ensembles and soloists, including the Tabernacle Choir and Orchestra at Temple Square. He is also an accomplished pianist, including performance as the youngest of 84 "Rhapsody in Blue" pianists as part of the 1984 Los Angeles Summer Olympics Opening Ceremonies. He holds degrees in music composition from Brigham Young University and the University of Minnesota, and a Doctorate of Musical Arts in Conducting from the University of Utah.

# **ELENA DAUGHTERY**

Elena Daughtery, originally from the Czech Republic, is a collaborative pianist at the University of Texas in Tyler. Prior to this appointment she served as a full-time accompanist and instructor of class piano at Northwestern State University of Louisiana, Conservatory of Bratislava, Slovakia, and was an adjunct instructor/ collaborative pianist at Northwestern State University of Louisiana. Mrs. Daughtery earned her Bachelor of Music and Master of Music from the Northwestern State University of Louisiana as well as Master of Business Administration from Louisiana State University in Shreveport.
